(Hong Kong, 26 October 2011), On October 21, 2011, the Round-table Dialogue between the Honorable Dato’ Sri Mohd Najib Tun Abdul

Razak, Prime Minister of Malaysia and CEOs from Chinese Enterprises of the 8th China-ASEAN Business and Investment Summit, which was hosted by Ministry of Commerce of China, Ministry of International Trade and Industry of Malaysia and China Council for the Promotion of International Trade, was grandly held in the city of Nanning, Guangxi Province, China. Mr. Wang Dong, Chairman of Beijing Enterprises Holdings Limited, Messrs. In addition, the Prime Minister hopes that BEWG and other Chinese enterprises can provide necessary support to the environmental protection industry in Malaysia, and carry out more sewage treatment projects, environmental pollution treatment projects and waste treatment projects in Malaysia.



This Round-table Dialogue provided a significant platform for Chinese enterprises and Malaysian Government to launch a direct and constructive dialogue and strengthened the communication between BEWG and Malaysian Government, which lays a solid foundation for smooth execution of Pantai project and for potential cooperation in other fields in the future.
